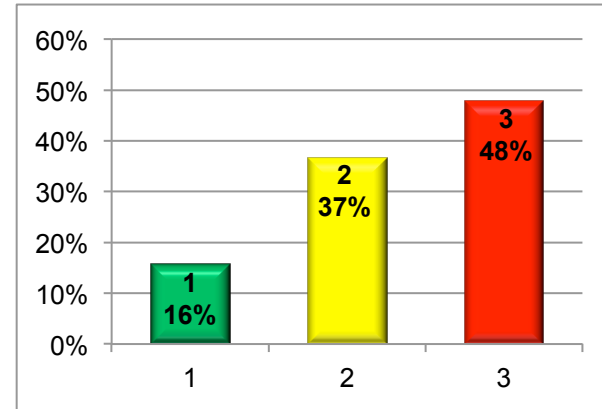

ORAL HEALTH REPORT CARD



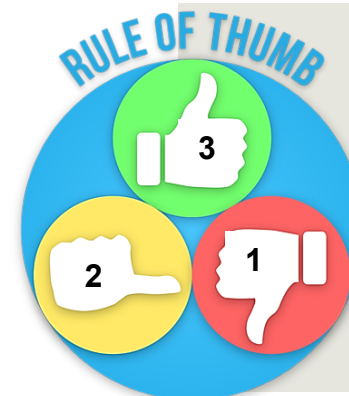
Each year, we provide the schools with a report card demonstrating the oral health of their student population. This graph shows the oral health scores for all 66 schools combined.



Score 1 -Preventive Care -No visual signs of problems with teeth and gums
 Score 2 -Restorative Care -Moderate signs or symptoms of gum infection (4 or less cavities)
 Score 3 -Urgent Treatment -Advanced dental disease including signs of pain and infection (5 or more cavities)

PATIENT SATISFACTION

At the end of each dental visit, patients are asked how they felt about their dental visit using the rule of thumb satisfaction scale.



The SBL Dental Team scored a 2.76 out of 3 patient satisfaction score.

As the Director of Healthy Communities, I am pleased to announce that FY2016 was a very successful year. Guided by our mission statement and the hard work of our clinical staff, the support of our administrative team and our continued partnerships with 66 local elementary and secondary schools, a Head Start program, local health departments, the Regional Office of Education #11, Lake Land College, our volunteer dentists, and other vital community partners, we were able to provide dental care for over 3,000 children.

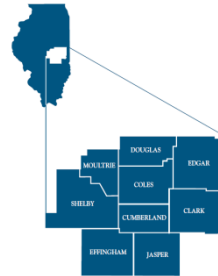


WHO WE ARE

Our staff consists of dental hygienists, dental assistants, and staff and volunteer dentists.

The program serves a nine-county service area including Clark, Coles, Cumberland, Douglas, Edgar, Effingham, Jasper, Moultrie, and Shelby counties.

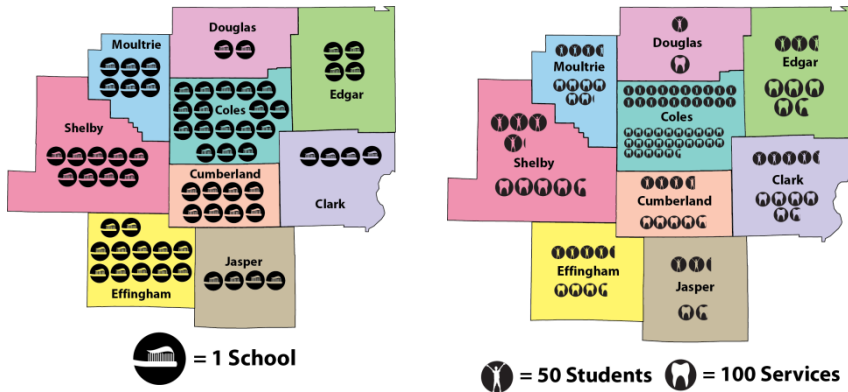

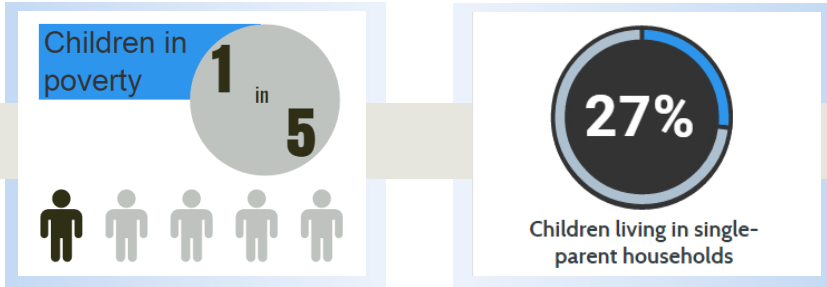

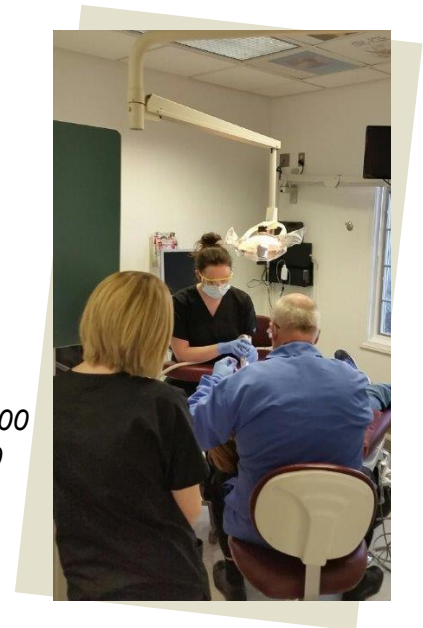
