






**DRINKING AND DRIVING** (High schoolers who have ridden in a car driven by someone (including themselves) who had been using drugs or alcohol)





MARIJUANA USE (Students who have used marijuana in the past year)







**PERCEIVED RISK OF HARM** (Students thinking there is a *moderate* to *great risk* in using marijuana once or twice a week)



E-CIGARETTES OR OTHER VAPING PRODUCTS USE (Students who have used e-




#### Bullying

**CYBERBULLYING** (Students who have been bullied, harassed, or had rumors spread on the Internet, social media, or through text messages in the past 12 months)







#### School Experiences

**SCHOOL CLIMATE** (Students who feel that it is *pretty much* or *very true* that there is a teacher or some other adult at their school who really cares about them)






SCHOOL SAFETY (Students who agree or strongly agree that they feel safe in their school)




